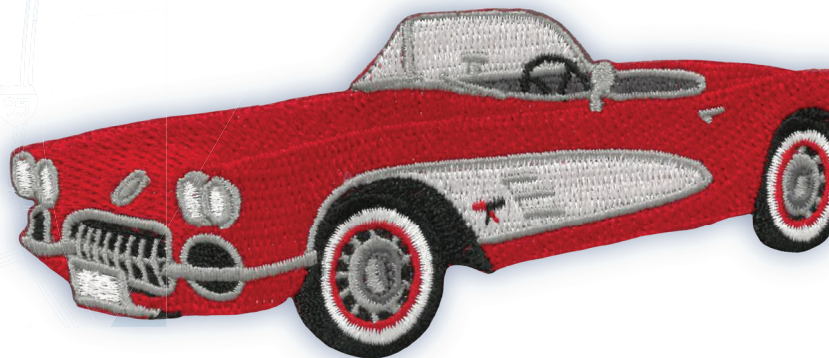

# Cartersville Museum City Highlights

## **AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE TRAIL:**

The trail showcases 19 sites and is led by several local historians. Visit a former Rosenwald School, the Black Pioneer Cemetery, Melvinia Shields Memorial, a Toni Morrison Bench by the Road, the Bartow History Museum, and more highlights of Bartow's rich African American history.

## **BOOTH WESTERN ART MUSEUM:**

This Smithsonian Affiliate Museum in downtown Cartersville houses the country's most extensive collection of Western American Art. Guests are invited to See America's Story through contemporary Western artwork, a Presidential Gallery, a Civil War art gallery, and an interactive children's gallery. Pre-arranged group dining options are available.

## **ETOWAH INDIAN MOUNDS HISTORIC**

**SITE:** Home to several thousand Native Americans from 1000 A.D. to 1550 A.D., Etowah Mounds is the most intact Mississippian Culture site in the Southeast. View earthen mounds, a plaza, a village site, borrow pits, a defensive ditch, and artifacts in the museum or walk along the nature trail.

## **HISTORIC DOWNTOWN CARTERSVILLE:**

With 14 chef-owned restaurants & various boutique shops, Cartersville's charming, walkable downtown is a perfect destination for a dine-around or a free afternoon of shopping.

**LAKEPOINT STATION:** A perfect indoor/outdoor hangout for kids' groups offering an Arcade, Clip N' Climb, Laser Tag, Rollerball, and Mini-Golf, as well as an on-site St. Angelo's pizza and Sweets FRO-YO.

**OLD CAR CITY USA:** The world's largest known classic car junkyard. Wander through miles of trails encompassing 4,000 classic cars being reclaimed by nature. Additional must-sees include the owner's extensive Styrofoam cup folk art collection and Elvis Presley's last automobile.

**PETTIT CREEK FARMS:** Largest Camel Herd in Georgia! You may see a camel, zebra, Patagonian Cavy, emu, herds of ponies, and buffalo roaming, not to mention the proverbial donkey, goats, sheep, and more.

**RED TOP MOUNTAIN:** A breathtaking destination on Lake Allatoona, it is perfect for groups seeking outdoor activities. Guided group hikes, paddling, archery, and educational & interpretive programs are available.

## **ROSELAWN HOUSE MUSEUM:**

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this beautifully restored Victorian mansion was once the home of nationally renowned evangelist Samuel Porter Jones. A Springtime must-see, Rose Lawn has been honored as a Historic Garden of Georgia featuring over 200 heritage roses. Group dining options, unique tours, and event spaces are available.

## **SAVOY AUTOMOBILE MUSEUM:**

This world-class museum connects people to the cultural diversity of the automobile. Through changing exhibits, educational programs, and engaging experiences, individuals can appreciate the beauty and history of automobiles. On-site café with group dining options available.

## **TELLUS SCIENCE MUSEUM:**

This Smithsonian Affiliate Museum offers a walk through history past millions of years of dinosaurs, reptiles, and giant mammals. Guests will discover how the Earth was formed billions of years ago and walk among hundreds of beautiful gems and minerals. Planetarium shows, gem panning, and other special exhibits are also available. The café caters to pre-arranged group meals.

**TERMINUS:** As Georgia's 1st full-size Cable Wake park, Terminus offers a premiere watersport experience at its cable wake facility and an Aqua Park with a giant inflatable water playground and obstacle course.
